2012 Pinewood Derby Agenda

The Pack 414 Pinewood Derby schedule is as follows (Try to be there early. Your car may not qualify and may need adjustments - a worktable and necessary tools will be available at the church hall):

Registration:	9:00 AM	to	11:00 AM
Car Judging:	11:00 AM	to	12:00 noon
Races:	12:00 noon	to	2:00 PM
Intermission:	2:00 PM*	to	2:15 PM
Pack Finals:	2:15 PM*	to	3:00 PM

(If the races conclude earlier/later than anticipated start/end times will be adjusted)

The cars will be judged for the following awards:

- Best Design + Honorable Mention
- Best Craftsmanship + Honorable Mention
- Most Original + Honorable Mention
- Best of Show

All races will proceed in the following manner:

- Starting with the Tiger Den, proceeding up through the Dens, and concluding with the Adult-Sibling division, each car will run three heats, each heat being run on a different lane.
- All cars will complete a heat before any cars run a subsequent heat.
- The slowest heat time will be dropped and a cars overall score will be the average of the other two heat times.
- The three fastest overall cars in each Den will be awarded trophies at the Blue-Gold Banquet.
- Participants in the Adult-Sibling division will be awarded ribbons at the derby.

The Pack Finals will proceed in the following manner:

- The **SIX** fastest non-Tiger cars (Adult-Sibling cars excluded) will race for the Pack Championship.
- The cars that qualify for the finals will be given 15 minutes to adjust, re-lube, etc. before the finals if they desire, however, the cars will need to be re-inspected before racing in the finals if this does occur.
- After the track has been wiped down, each car will run two heats down the center lane. All cars will complete a heat before any cars run a subsequent heat. The running order in the finals will be 6th fastest qualifier to fastest qualifier.

- The slowest heat time will be dropped and a cars final score will be the remaining heat time.
- All **SIX** Pack finalists will be awarded trophies at the Blue-Gold Banquet and will be the Pack's representatives at the District Mall Derby
- The top **SIX** Tigers will race in their division at the mall.

FOOD

As the Pack has done in the past, in order to feed this hungry group, we are again asking the scout families to donate food items. We are asking each family to bring to the derby the following items:
